We are poised on the precipice of a brand-new year where we have the ability to join with our sisters in person and celebrate the new vision of the league as we serve God!

So very many topics were discussed over the National meetings held in conjunction with National Convention. Following are some of the highlights.

- Resolution 2022.01 Enact Federal Legislation to Address Food Loss and Waste
- The moratorium on Life Membership has been lifted with some minor changes in criteria! Watch for Life Member news!
- Strategic planning is moving along nicely! Check cwl.ca for updates!
- New versions of the Constitution and Bylaws and National Manual of Policy and Procedure will be available after approval by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops. Expected date is December 1, 2022.
- Faith, Service and Social Justice Guidelines have been prepared. Look for them on the website! Great resource for newly elected councils.

- Communications protocol during these years of transition was discussed. All communications will go through council presidents and secretaries to be distributed as is that council's custom. This will be both top-down and bottom-up communications. (Sounds easy enough but it has sure required a lot of thinking for me!)
- New Development and Peace projects are
 - Sustained and equitable primary education for girls and boys living in rural areas in Afghanistan
 - Inclusive governance for women of Kasenga through functional literacy in the Democratic Republic of Congo
 - Food and nutritional security and climate change in the Sahel region of Mali, Niger and Burkina Faso
- Watch for new annual reporting processes!

Our provincial website is frequently updated, so check it from time to time. The next event on our schedule in Manitoba is the Day of Reflection on October 22.
